1. Ten grants, 150 EUR each, are being offered to MSc and PhD students to cover the costs of the TRACE 2016 fee and accommodation during the conference (11-15 May 2016 in the Białowieża National Park Guest House, including breakfasts).
2. Grants will not cover the costs of travel and of meals not included in the conference and accommodation fee.
3. To apply for funding it is necessary to send correctly filled in application form (available on conference web page: www.trace2016.com) to 2016.trace@gmail.com by 20 March 2016.
4. To apply for funding it is necessary to prove your student status by sending e.g. letter from supervisor/university, scanned valid student card/ID along with the application form.
5. To apply for funding active participation in the TRACE 2016 conference (oral or poster presentation) is required. Please submit registration form and an abstract of oral or poster presentation by 29 February 2016.
6. Grant selection will be on merit based on:
 - a) the scientific experience and achievements of the applicant (based on cv, list of previous conference contributions and publications provided in the application form) and
 - b) the quality of the contribution submitted to the TRACE 2016 conference (based on abstract submitted in the application form).
7. The conference board will decide to whom support will be granted, and if necessary an external expert will be involved.
8. There is no legal obligation for the funding agency and conference board to grant any request.
9. Results of the grant selection will be send to all applicants by e-mail and will be posted on the conference web page (www.trace2016.com) by 31 March 2016
10. Awards will be transferred directly from the funding agency to conference organizers who will cover the costs of grant winner participation in TRACE 2016.
11. The winners will receive certificates of grant receiving.
